DC/19/1113/FUL	9/4/2019	Lion House The Street Blythburgh Suffolk	The erection of a single storey extension to gable end and the erection of a 1.8m high closeboard fence with wooden fence posts along roadside/A12 garden boundary. (Set back 1.5 metre from pavement with planting in front)

Cllr Mackley gave an overview of the application giving a history of Lion House showing extensions that once existed. He went on to discuss the recent purchase of land, the reuse of a Heritage statement from a previous planning application on the purchased land and the actual length of the proposed fence. The Councillors discussed the proposed planting in front of the hedge and the archaeological importance of the site. They concluded they had no objection to the actual proposed extension or fence but did wish requirements be added for professional inspection of materials from any footings dug and type and maintenance of the plantings.
