

B1125 traffic management ballot results

Following the public meeting on 8th August at which many interesting points were raised and questions asked (See minutes of the meeting) the results of the associated ballot were overwhelmingly in favour of Option 1 - To close the Dunwich Road at the Junction of B1125 and B1387.

The total votes cast were 54 which represents 38% of the 144 ballot papers issued.
The results were:

Option 1	Block south end of Dunwich Rd	44
Option 2	Modify the B1125/B1387 junction	8
Option 3	No change	2

Of the 90 ballots not returned we have to assume that, apart from a few people being away, the majority of them are indifferent to the result and are happy to live with whatever is decided.

The Parish Council will now forward the village's decision to the B1125 Working Party which, in the view of the Council, is a clear mandate for making the Angel Lane/Dunwich Road a No Through Road with access and egress only at the the Angel Lane/A12 junction, the Street and Chapel Road.

Whether or not this actually goes ahead is dependant on many factors not least of which is will Sizewell C actually go ahead since the project still faces many technical, legal and financial issues which have yet to be resolved.
